


IMPACT REPORT

safe in Eshkol but also helping them heal from the emotional wounds and trauma inflicted by years of constant attack and terror.

Here is Jillian Bork's story:

I was put into the foster care system at just three months old, and then adopted at five. From an early age, I experienced much abuse. Both times I came to the Dream Center, it was a result of my choice to leave unhealthy relationships, which unfortunately had put me at a high risk of homelessness. My depression and anxiety had worsened while I was on my own, and I struggled with internal battles. I was tired of life. I needed a new start.

The Dream Center is providing a safe space for me and my child. I finally get a chance to rest and ease my mind which allows me to focus clearly on the present. My goal is to find peace, which isn't something I feel I can put a time frame on. I also want to build my relationship with God and create a stronger love for myself.

I am grateful my child and I have a roof over our heads and food on the table consistently. I have also continued my college journey, pursuing my degree in Psychology and a career as a Forensic Psychologist. JF
